With the recent HSE court cases against employers who breach the Health and Safety at Work Act 1974 receiving large fines, it is essential to assess your first aid requirements including first aid training and maintain them.

## The Corporate Manslaughter Act 2007

The Corporate Manslaughter and Homicide Act 2007 ensures that companies and organisations can be found guilty of corporate manslaughter as a result of serious management failures, which results in a gross breach of duty of care. This clarifies the criminal liabilities of companies and organisations in the United Kingdom where serious failures in the management of Health and Safety has resulted in a fatality. Prosecutions will be of the corporate body and not individuals, however the liability of board members and directors is unaffected under Health and Safety law.
